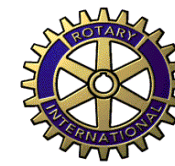

Winning Team (Advanced) — Stamford Endowed Schools

On 21st February we held our fourth Technology Tournament at Leicester Grammar School. With eleven schools from across the County, some 144 students and 12 teachers taking part, it was, as the Cont/d

Head of Design said—"A great success, the best yet".

Arranged in teams of four, and at three levels of complexity, the students had to build a launch platform and send a capsule (a golf training ball) some 3 metres into the air. At its simplest, the capsule then had to land within a designated circle. The second level of complexity involved bringing the capsule down by parachute, and at the most difficult level, sending the capsule skywards in a vehicle (cup), which had to separate from the capsule at a metre from launch. Again, capsule, parachute, and launch vehicle had to land within the designated circle.

We set these tasks to put the participants' STEM skills to the fore, involving them in team work, further testing ability in planning, design, ingenuity, and innovation, along with both manual and presentation skills. The British Science Association accredits the tournament and competitors can apply for a Crest Certificate.

It was good to see all those taking part so committed, focused and involved.

We are supported in our efforts by the kind sponsorship of the Sir Thomas White charity, along with companies Pick Everard, and Hodges & Drake. Our thanks for their outstanding support.

Sir Thomas White presented trophies, and both Hodges & Drake and Pick Everard added to the occasion by inviting the winning team to their offices for the day, further enhancing the link between design and the workplace.
